

Maths facts from Year 2



Learning these Maths facts from Year 2 will really help you in Year 3.

1	A quadrilateral has 4 sides
2	A pentagon has 5 sides
3	A hexagon has 6 sides
4	A octagon has 8 sides
5	A decagon has 10 sides
6	You should be able to tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes
7	These are the symbols for = equals, < less than and > greater than
8	If you multiply any number by 1, you get the same number you started with
9	You can add numbers together in any order – you will get the same answer e.g. 4+5 is the same as 5+4
10	You can multiply numbers in any order – you will get the same answer
11	If you swap the order of numbers in subtraction, you will get a different answer
12	To find half of a number, divide it by 2
13	Length is measured in centimetres (cm) and metres (m)
14	Mass (sometimes called weight) is measured in grams (g) and kilograms (kg)
15	Temperature is measured in degrees Celsius (sometimes called Centigrade) (°C)
16	Capacity is measured in litres (l) and millilitres (ml)
17	In England, we use pounds (£) and pence for money
18	There are 60 minutes in an hour
19	There are 24 hours in a day
20	There are 60 seconds in a minute
21	You should know your 2, 5 and 10 times-tables
22	You should be able to count beyond 100
23	You should know your number bonds to 100 that end in a zero e.g. 40 and 60 make 100
24	You should recognise the fractions $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$ in numbers and diagrams
25	$\frac{2}{4}$ (two quarters) is the same as $\frac{1}{2}$
